What is time?

- Several ways to express time in a language
- In linguistics: tense and grammatical aspects
- Temporal *reference expressions*
 - On Friday
 - March 31st, 2007
 - In the late 90s
- Several ways to express the *same* time information
 - Christmas Day
 - December 25
 - Navidad
 - Weihnachten



Temporal Information can be normalized to some standard format

- Temporal Information can be normalized to some standard format
 - expressions with same semantics
 \rightarrow same value in standard format
 March 28, 2011 \rightarrow 2011-03-28
 2011/03/28 \rightarrow 2011-03-28
 today \rightarrow 2011-03-28

 Temporal Information can be organized hierarchically

- Temporal Information can be organized hierarchically
 - different granularities (day, month, ...)

- Explicit expressions
- Implicit expressions
- Relative expressions

- **Explicit expressions**
 - refer to specific point in time
 - carry all information explicitly

January 25, 2010

November 2012

the 7th century

can be normalized without further knowledge

Implicit expressions

- names of holidays
- names of events
 - Independency Day 2001
 - Labor Day 1999
- can be normalized if semantics is known:
- Labor Day \rightarrow first Monday in September

- Relative expressions
 - may be underspecified or deictic

today

January 12

two weeks later

- context infEormation is needed
- \rightarrow reference time
- \rightarrow relation to reference time

Example:

Document Creation Time: 1998-04-18 Hungarian astronaut Bertalan Farkas is leaving for the United States to start a new career, he said today. ...On May 22, 1995, Farkas was made a brigadier general, and the following year he was appointed military attache ...However, cited by District of Columbia traffic police in December for driving under the influence of ...

Extracting temporal expressions


- Temporal tagger
- Similar to NER but for time only
- TimeML format

Why we care?

- Temporal landmarks
- Temporal evolution



Wisdom of crowds

- Calendar annotation for free
 - Take all hot topics for a year
 - Annotate events that people care
 - Use that to learn what maybe relevant for that date the next year
- Repeating events
 - Elections, sport championships, etc.
- Unexpected events that will be remembered - 9/11, Japan earthquake, Chilean miners, etc.

Document lifecycle

- Document creation time (ts)
- Availability of temporal expressions
- Updates as maintenance
- Topical relevance
- Emphasis on freshness:
 - the extent to which information is recent, current, up-to-date







EXPLORING DATA WITH TEMPORAL INFORMATION

Temporal value

- Documents/web pages
 - Timestamp + temporal expressions
- Queries
 - Trends & popularity
- Temporal value per source
 - Can we associate a temporal utility value at a source?

Correlating sources

- Identify event-based hashtags, for timeline creation
- Currently using historic/past data
- Find most temporally significant hashtags
- Use multiple signals: Twitter search logs + related Wikipedia article popularity
- Automatic timeline-generation



Combining sources


- CrowdTiles
- Web + Twitter
 + Wikipedia
- Get a sense of what is happening now



Observation

- Different crowds on different sources
- Two crowds of people
 - Authors/searchers on Twitter
 - Editors/browsers on Wikipedia
- Correlation between signals from the two crowds
 - People search for what is happening
 - People edit Wikipedia with what is happening
- Combining and integrating different sources by time

Archiving and looking back

- News articles & Wikipedia are fine for main events
- What about stuff that is not so trending?
- What did people say at the Oscars 2011?
- Mario Balotelli at Euro 2012

Problems

- Duplicate and near-duplicate detection across sources
- Temporal summaries
- Temporal precedence by source
- Archiving
- Ranking by temporal value
- Temporal aware search engines
- Synchronization and latency
- Can time help or escape the filter bubble?
- Evaluation

Conclusions

- Temporal information for organizing content is becoming more important
- Exciting area for combining different sources
- Lots of opportunities to improve current search experience
- Time is a cross-cutting aspect
